Why Tiggy's?

We aim to make your child's first learning experience, a stimulating and enjoyable one whilst providing the very highest quality care in a small nursery that prides itself on the individual attention afforded to every child.

We follow Montessori philosophy in all that we do and are the only Montessori nursery locally, you would have to go to Birmingham or Cheshire to find another!

An enforced change of premises in 2024, means we can no longer mention our triple outstanding Ofsted reports but the same staff team, same resources and same philosophy are all at our new location. In 2025, Tiggy's re-registered with Ofsted as a Limited Company with Jo and Nicola as shared owners after almost 20 years of Nicola as sole owner.

What's different about us? – We're Montessori!

Dr. Maria Montessori emphasised, "We must respect and understand every child."

It is essential to attune ourselves to children's emotions, comprehend their thoughts, and appreciate their perspectives. By meeting them at their level and approaching their experiences with empathy and a child-centred mindset, we can genuinely understand and connect with them.

Only through such deep understanding can we provide education and support that truly meets their needs. Each child is a unique individual, not merely an extension of their parents.

Children develop at their own pace, and Montessori pedagogy honours this natural developmental rhythm. In the Montessori environment, children are empowered to independently choose activities that engage their interests—an embodiment of respecting each child's intrinsic growth. They have this freedom to choose their own play for most of the day in a relaxed, happy and friendly atmosphere which creates a calm but harmonious nursery environment.

Children explore our Montessori learning areas – Practical Life, Sensorial, Mathematics, Language, Cultural and Creative, in addition to a wide variety of other high quality resources inside and outside. Small group Montessori curriculum teaching takes place in a child's final year before school to develop their knowledge & understanding of the world. We have a cooking activity most weeks on different days so everyone can join in. Our secure outdoor area is open in all weathers to ensure plenty of fresh air and exercise and there are regular walks around the local area as well as weekly Forest School trips for our older children and a weekly dance class.

Young and old are fully integrated at Tiggy's, with younger ones learning from the older ones and the older ones gaining a sense of responsibility by showing their younger friends what to do and helping them when necessary.



The Montessori Method:

Fosters True Independence

From the earliest years, children are given the tools and time to care for themselves and their environment. By doing things for themselves, they develop confidence, competence, and a deep sense of self-worth.

Honours Each Child's Natural Rhythm

Montessori education follows the individual pace of each child. Instead of pushing standardised expectations, we observe and respond to where the child is developmentally, allowing growth to unfold organically and joyfully.

Cultivates Internal Discipline

Rather than relying on rewards or punishments, children learn to make thoughtful choices and take responsibility for their actions. Through purposeful work and freedom within limits, they build intrinsic motivation and self-regulation.

Builds Emotional Intelligence and Empathy

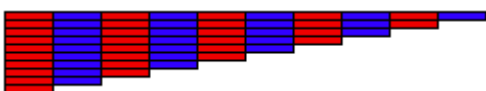
Respectful communication, conflict resolution, and grace and courtesy lessons are foundational. Children learn to name their emotions, listen to others, and solve problems peacefully, all within a calm and respectful community.

Inspires Creativity and Independent Thinking

Montessori environments are designed for open-ended exploration. Children are encouraged to ask questions, make discoveries, and express themselves through hands-on materials that spark curiosity and innovation.

Connects Children to Nature and Real Life

The classroom extends into the natural world. Through gardening, outdoor exploration, care of nature, and real-life practical tasks, children gain a sense of stewardship and a grounded understanding of their place in the world.



A little bit more about us...

It would be hard to find locally, a more longstanding & loyal staff team than the one at Tiggy's! We are 8 mature, friendly and very experienced, qualified nursery practitioners. 3 of the team have been at Tiggy's for over 20 years and 2 have been in childcare for over 35 years. All have a Level 3 childcare qualification and 3 have Level 6 qualifications of which 2 are Montessori teachers. 2 staff are also qualified Forest School leaders. Most of the staff have children (some school age or all grown up!) and have worked together for many years at Tiggy's and cared for 100's of children, as we love what we do.

We always have the time to talk with, listen to and play with the children because of our low ratios and so we get to know every child really well whilst they are with us. We know the right time to step in to support a child but more importantly for their development, when to let them be independent and try things for themselves.

We place great importance on being polite, kind and helpful – part of the Montessori curriculum relates to 'grace and courtesy' and we support children in learning about being respectful of each other, adults and the nursery environment. Tiggy's children are well known for their high standards of behaviour when they start at local schools. We involve parents and carers as much as you want to be involved but always aim to work in partnership to best support the needs of your child.

Dear Nicola – Firstly, thank you. You and your team have left such a lasting impression on us as a family, I am not sure where to begin..

As a first time Mum with no friends with experience of choosing a nursery, trying to find somewhere I would be happy to leave my first born seemed like an impossible task. I had absolutely no idea what I was doing and the only advice I was given was 'go with your gut' What on earth did that mean? I thought. Off I went to do the rounds of all the local nurseries and as soon as I walked in through the doors of Tiggy's, boom, there it was! The vibe your setting gives off is immeasurable. I can't put my finger on what it is, exactly.

One of the main draws for me was the age of your staff, I wanted someone that has been there, done that, cleaned up the vomit and changed the T shirt. I want someone that will cuddle my child to stop the tears and someone who has very successfully raised small humans into big ones.

You have all helped shape me into the mother I am today. I will never forget the day you approached me about potty training. We had tried lots of times but you quite abruptly told me to do it now as he was getting too old. I'll be honest, I was quite taken a back so I went home and thought to myself 'Right, I'll send him in pants and he can wee and poo all over them and see how they like it' The following day he went in his pants with about 5 changes of clothes and the little monkey didn't have a single accident! A week after he was totally dry, day and night.

The Tiggy's team are highly experienced, trustworthy and a genuinely lovely group of people. The Montessori philosophy of using natural materials where possible really appeals to us. There are no flashing, noisy, plastic toys here. Instead, Tiggy's is full of high quality wooden and natural resources, making them a joy for children to play with and explore. We also love the open-ended play opportunities, where children can use their own imagination to build, design and create without prompting. Tiggy's also offers excellent external experiences such as woodland adventures, sledging in the snow, walking with alpacas and of course their wonderful Forest School provision. Our children could not have had a better start to their education,

A place is confirmed once a fully completed booking form and the non-refundable registration fee £40 has been paid. Further information on nursery funding is provided when you have enrolled your child.

2, 3 & 4 YEAR OLD EARLY EDUCATION FUNDING

We offer funding to all eligible children subject to space being available. We do not charge for funded hours but as we provide many extra services over and above what we are legally required to do, eg a Montessori education, a highly experienced and fully qualified staff team with staff ratios exceeding legal minimum requirements, online access to your child's development profile, daily snack, weekly cooking, Birthday, Christmas and school leaver events & gifts, Forest School for children in their final year and much more, **we have to charge an hourly enrichment fee for every funded hour that a child attends** to ensure the nursery can be sustainable and provide the high quality care & education it is known for.

Early Education Funding 15 hours and 30 hours for 2, 3 & 4 year olds***

Enrichment fee **£2.38** per hour

If you do not wish to pay the additional service fee, we strongly suggest you look at alternative nursery provision. Legally, we have to offer a fully funded option – please contact us by email for more information once you have visited the nursery

*****Nursery funding – parents are responsible for re-validating funding codes every 3 months**

Our school uses



We use an online record keeping system, My Montessori Child, to track and record your child's progress. All parents have individual password access to their child's record. Every child also has a photo book (yellow book to the children) to accompany the online system. Both meet all requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage and build into a wonderful memento of their nursery years.
